Alvera Nyirampfumukoye, 60, used to worry that the torrential rains which thrash Rwanda might carry her house downhill and that her land wasn't producing enough food for her family of seven. Erosion was at the heart of both problems. But today, a WFP program has made it possible to terrace the steep hills in her neighborhood, keeping the precious top soil in place. Local people earn food rations in exchange for creating the terraces. More than 90 percent of donations to Friends of WFP go toward programs like this one.
